General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and Data Protection Act 2018



What does your church need to know? Are you acting in accordance with the new rules? What do you need to change?

What? Since May 25th, 2018, data protection rules have changed. In the autumn, information sessions are held across Wales on the implications for the Presbyterian Church of Wales.

For Who? The sessions are for PCW ministers and employees. They are also suitable for elders, especially church secretaries and treasurers. It is suggested that at least one from each church attends. They are also suitable for the officers of Association and Presbyteries, the General Assembly and the Boards, Departments and Sub-Committees.
